6 When word came to Sanballat, Tobiah, Geshem the Arab and the rest of our enemies that I had rebuilt the wall and not a gap was left in it—though up to that time I had not set the doors in the gates—² Sanballat and Geshem sent me this message: “Come, let us meet together in one of the villages^[a] on the plain of Ono. “But they were scheming to harm me; ³ so I sent messengers to them with this reply: “I am carrying on a great project and

cannot go down. Why should the work stop while I leave it and go down to you?"⁴ Four times they sent me the same message, and each time I gave them the same answer.⁵ Then, the fifth time, Sanballat sent his aide to me with the same message, and in his hand was an unsealed letter⁶ in which was written:



You can check your attendance online

by sending us a chat on the webpage, make a comment on the Facebook page, send a text saying present with your name(s) at 440-315-2791

or clicking of the bar at the top of the app page, choosing About Links, clicking on the Guest/Prayer card and filling it out. This helps us to know who is a part of the worship service and who we need to make sure we are checking in on.

If you download our church app from either the App Store or Google Play Store, you can 1) give your offering through the App, 2) fill out a Guest Information Card, 3) contact us with a prayer request, or 4) go to the church website. One you have the app touch it on your phone, touch the three lines in front of New Life At Calvary. Touch "About & Links". Touch and push the phone screen

upwards to choose the action you want to do. Once the page comes up, touch the side of the screen, and push upwards and fill out the information. Don't forget to push submit for guests and for messages or prayer requests. You can still watch recorded services, bulletins, life-sharing lessons and sermons as before with the app.

GIVING OPTIONS

Did You Know There Are 8 Different Ways for You To Give Financially For The Work Of Christ At New Life At Calvary?

1. You can set up an account online at and have your offering sent directly to the church's bank account. You can designate which accounts to give to. You can also set up an automatic deduction from your account and give one time, weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, or yearly and not have to worry about falling behind on your giving. You can use a bank account, debit card, or credit card to do this. Once signed in, you will be taken to a secured site. Click on the Donations and Offerings above to do this.
2. If you have Cash App you can send your offering to \$2NLAC Phone # 216-854-4853.
3. You can **give cash, checks, or money orders during the regular worship service.** Or drop it off at the church.
4. You can **have us set up an account for you in the office** and we can automatically have your offering sent to your church's bank account on whatever basis you want. It can be one time, weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, or yearly. You can use a bank account, a debit card, or a credit card to do this.
5. You can do your **online banking** and set up the church as one of your bill payments. The bank will mail the church your check automatically as often as you want it to be sent, weekly, bi-weekly or monthly. You need a checking account or savings account to do this and do online banking. The mailing address is 2020 E. 79th Street, Cleveland, OH 44103
6. You can **mail in your offering** through the mail at New Life At Calvary, 2020 E. 79th Street, Cleveland, OH 44103.

*We encourage you to only use your credit card when you are paying for items at the church such as tickets or t shirts. Never place a large offering on a credit card.

** Your offering goes the furthest when you either place it directly in the offering plate or when you have your bank mail your offering to the church under the online bill pay plan.

Celebrating the 91st birthday of Margaret Mallory

Covenant Partner of New Life At Calvary. Margaret was born and raised in Cotton Plant, Arkansas on January 30, 1932. She is one of 12 siblings, 8 of them are still living.

Margaret was born and raised Presbyterian. She

was Christened as a newborn at 30 days old. Her grandmother and mother were both members of the Presbyterian Church. Margaret attended Presbyterian schools, which were like Catholic Schools. She has been a member of the Presbyterian Church all her life. Margaret never expected to live into her 90's. Margaret's mother passed away in her 30's and her grandmother also passed away in her 30's. Margaret is very grateful to have lived such a long life.

Margaret helped to raise her two younger sisters. Entering 2022, Margaret was able to talk to all her living siblings on a phone call. Margaret has traveled throughout her life. Her husband of 29 years, Mr. Wilkins, was in the United States Airforce, where they lived in Chicago, Missouri, Saratoga Springs, NY, and the country of Norway. After Mr. Wilkins passed away, she met and married Joe Mallory in Cleveland, OH on March 25, 1980. They both were members of Calvary Presbyterian church and were married by Rev. Mary H. Ryan.



Margaret joined Calvary Presbyterian Church (Calvary) on November 16, 1969, under the leadership of Rev. Roger Shoup, Rev. Brooke Gibson, and Rev. Mary H. Ryan. She still considered herself a part of her Chicago Presbyterian Church family as the pastor

told her that she was always a member. One piece

of advice that Margaret received from her mother was, "wherever you go in this world always find a women's group." Margaret said, this advice always proved helpful. She joined the Calvary Presbyterian Women's Guild during her first weeks of visiting the church. She said, "back then you could find a Women's Guild in every church. The women looked out for each other. When you moved, they would give you advice on where to look for jobs, where to find a house, good neighborhoods to live in and help on finding good schools for your children." Margaret served as the 1st African American Moderator of the Women's Guild.

Margaret has been a faithful member of the Women's Guild. She has served as a member and in various officer positions. Margaret and Joe served Calvary Presbyterian Church faithfully. Joe would often tease that he wished his wife would stop volunteering him for things. They both served as Elders, they served the Saturday school program, and volunteered wherever there was a need in the church. After his death, on July 5, 1997, Margaret continued to serve as a dedicated member. She eventually would become a part of the merger between Glenville New Life Community Church (NLAC) and Calvary, becoming a Charter Member of New Life At Calvary on September 13, 2013. Margaret is a joyful member of NLAC, she is a prayer warrior and a devoted part of the Adult Sunday School class. We praise God for Margaret and celebrate 91 years of life.
