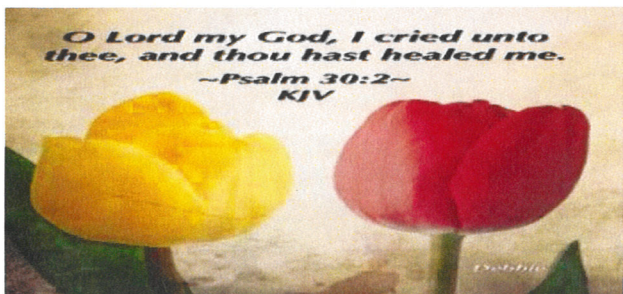
Marvin & Cassandra Rogers Farewell & Thanksgiving
