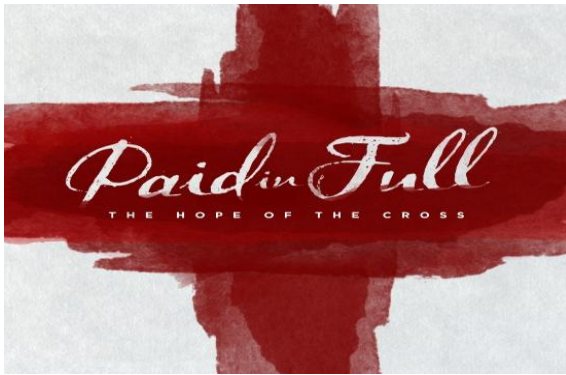

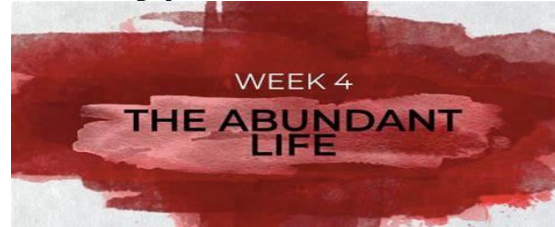
What Is Palm Sunday?

Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem on the Sunday before Easter, marking the beginning of Holy Week. It is a biblical event mentioned in each of the four canonical Gospels. Jesus rode into the city on a donkey on this day, symbolizing peace, fulfilling an ancient prophecy, and signifying his kingship. The crowds greeted him by spreading palm branches and cloaks on the road ahead and shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" and "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" as a sign of respect and homage.

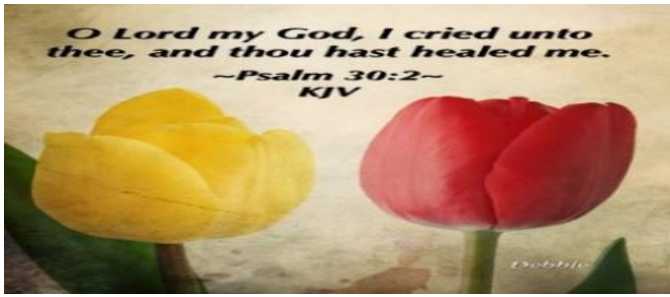


Unconventional Things to Give Up for Lent
