Minnie Olia Doaty, beloved mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, great-great-grandmother, and friend, peacefully transitioned to be with the Lord on July 1, 2026, in Cleveland, Ohio.

Affectionately known as MuDear, Minnie was born on March 22, 1920, in Crawfordsville, Arkansas, to Jacob and Laura (Bowers) Anderson. She was one of seven children and was preceded in death by her siblings: Lucille Chambers (Elmer), John Anderson (Laurel), Blanche Evers (Marshall), Leona Anderson, David Anderson and Erma Harris (Daniel).

After spending her childhood in Crawfordsville, MuDear married Horace Doaty in 1947 and moved to Cleveland, Ohio, in 1952.
